Lesson Plan for Elementary School Grades 1-4

1. Read Aloud

Gather and read: ***Route 66: Faces And Places Along America's Most Famous Road*** by Beth Bacon (Reedy Press, ISBN: 9781681066776). Talk about what makes Route 66 special: sports, nature, art, music, shopping, learning, etc.



2. Brainstorm

List the important places in your community for: sports, nature, art, music, shopping, learning, etc.

3. Gather Materials

Paper: Individual sheets or one long roll for the class.
Drawing Supplies: Crayons, pencils, paint & brushes.



4. Create and Share

Draw the places that are important to you, connecting them all with a road to create a personal map of your world.
Share your work with the students at your school.
